2,500 Gns for Top priced in calf Heifer

Selling for 2,500 Gns to R Morris's Buttergask Herd, Perthshire, was Graham Parkinson's in-calf Heifer **Donington Molly X9**, a Donington Pioneer daughter out of Donington Molly U34; in calf to Yarn Hill Wilbur – her Maternal Grand-dam is Dam of Donington Watchman who sold to the Cowford Herd in Perthshire for 9,000 Gns.

Two more in-calf Heifers sold to R Morris's Buttergask Herd; also from the Donington Herd; were: **Donington Diana X30**, a Foulness Leroy daughter out of Donington Diana R53, in-calf to Highbarn Thunderbolt – her Sire is sire of Donington Watchman and Donington Jessie V12 who was 2018 Royal Welsh Show Interbreed Champion, selling for 2350 Gns and **Donington Diana X50**, a Brandon Robber daughter out of Donington Diana T12, in-calf to Yarn Hill Wilbur, selling for 2,250 Gns.

Next highest was from the Auchmacoy Herd, Aberdeenshire, Sharon Buchan's in calf heifer; **Auchmacoy Violet W448**, an Auchmacoy Usama daughter out of Market Stainton Lucy L948, in-calf to Brackenhurst Warrior, selling to the Rand Farm Park Herd, Lincolnshire.

Top priced Maiden Heifer, was from HM & JM Needler's, Walmer Herd, Lincolnshire, **Walmer Lobelia Y1334**; a Hemingby Ian daughter out of Walmer Lobelia T1046; selling for 1,450 Gns to Rand Farm Park Herd.

Selling for 1,350 Gns was the Maiden Heifer from the Mann's Yarn Hill Herd, Suffolk, **Yarn Hill Lass Y740** a Hemingby Jaguar daughter out of Yarn Hill Lass T346; she went to the new Holthead Herd of Jonathan Bradley, West Yorkshire.

In the Bull Calf Section: top priced 11 month old bull from The Clough's Beverley Herd, Lincolnshire, was **Beverley Yukon**, sired by Highbarn Storm out of Beverley Gift W78, sold to the Wragby Herd of Geoff and Jenny Bolton, Lincolnshire, for 1,800 Gns. From the same Herd, Beverley Young Pretender, another son of Highbarn Storm out of Beverley Gift W30 sold for 1,400 Gns to W S Arnott & Son, Yorkshire.
