Lincoln Reds sell to highs of 8,000 Guineas & 7,500 Guineas

Lincoln Red Bull Trade at the Premier Pedigree Spring and Multibreeds Sale on Saturday 27th March 2021 at Melton Mowbray Market saw the highest and second highest priced Bulls; out of all the Breeds; and both from Ed Middleton's Hologate Herd: Hologate Yogi selling for 8,000 Gns to Michael Read's Hemingby Herd in Lincolnshire and Hologate Yeti selling for 7,500 Gns to Jonathan and Elaine Bradley's Holthead Herd in West Yorkshire. Hologate Yogi is sired by Auchmacoy Unwin and his Dam is Donington Jessie V12, she was the Beef Interbreeds Champion at the Royal Welsh Show in 2018. Hologate Yeti was judged Senior and Champion Bull sired by Highbarn Thunderbolt out of Donington Jessie V3.

A Mylius and Partners of St. Fort, Fife, sold Junior and Reserve Champion Bull, St. Fort Yodel for 3,500 Gns to John Carrick's D' Morley Herd in Norfolk; sired by Walmer Troy out of St. Fort Lady Mary S260; also selling from the St. Fort Herd was Junior Reserve Bull, St. Fort Yamaha for 3,200 Gns to Tom Dobell's Garnons Herd in Essex; sired by St. Fort Timber out of St. Fort Frosty N925.

Mr Needler's Walmer Herd, Lincolnshire; sold Walmer Yukon for 4,500 Gns to Mr Innes from Surrey; sired by Brackenhurst Ranger (who has won many Lincoln Red Championships) out of Walmer Lobelia T1067. Also from Mr Needler's Walmer Herd; selling for 3,000 Gns to Steve and Tina Skipworth's Adbury Park Herd, Berkshire, was Walmer Yanos sired by Hemingby Ian out of Walmer Sally G85.

A total of 6 out of 10 bulls forward sold to an overall average of: 4,950 Gns (£5,198)

5 Females sold out of 9 forward at an overall average of: 1,720 Gns (£1,806)

Top priced female was Julie Evans's Springwood Herd, Leicestershire, a Maiden Heifer Springwood Hazel Y157, sired by St. Fort Texas out of Springwood Hazel T102, sold for 2,100 Gns to Jamie Quinn and Sue Oliver's Axholme Herd, North Lincolnshire. Reserve Champion Female Brackenhurst Molly Y534 sired by Brackenhurst Uppercut out of Donington Molly P1, from the Nottingham Trent University's Brackenhurst Herd sold for 1,900 Gns to Will & Ellie Jackson's Othorpe Herd in Leicestershire.

John Capp's Handley Herd, Lincolnshire, sold his incalf Heifer, Handley Ophelia Y9 for 1,800 Gns to Tia and Chris Johnson's Springfield Herd, Lincolnshire. Sired by Hemingby Vanguard out of Wingland Ophelia U67 in calf to Handley Yeoman.

The winning Pen of a Pair of Heifers went to Julie Evans's, Springwood Herd for her Maiden Heifers, Springwood Hazel Y157 and Springwood Jessie Y161 both sired by St. Fort Texas.
